EFA Scholarship Application Entry Criteria for High School Students

To apply for the scholarship, an applicant must meet the following:

- Graduating from high school in the spring/summer 2009
- Applied to and/or accepted at a 4-year college or university on a full time basis starting Fall 2009. Acceptance to a 4-year college or university must be received before the scholarship can be awarded.
- Pursuing a degree program or course of study related to military / aerospace studies, such as science, technology, engineering and mathematics(STEM). Degree programs related to military needs will be considered.
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.5.
- Minimum SAT score of 1800 or minimum ACT score of 22.
- Student must reside in California

Selection Process

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of academic and leadership achievements, community involvement, extra curricular activities, and the personal essay.
